

Privacy Policy

This privacy policy (the “Privacy Policy”) explains how CureDuchenne collects, uses, and in some circumstances discloses personal information you provide through using this site (the “Site”). Please read this Privacy Policy before using the site or submitting any personal information. Your use of the Site constitutes your acceptance of the Privacy Policy and the associated Terms of Use. CureDuchenne reserve the right to modify or amend this Privacy Policy at any time. It is CureDuchenne’s practice to post any changes it makes this Privacy Policy on this page, and the date this Privacy Policy was last revised is identified at the top of this page. CureDuchenne encourage you to periodically review this Privacy Policy for the latest information on its privacy practices. CureDuchenne endeavors to notify you of any material changes to this Privacy Policy. CureDuchenne may notify you of these changes by email reminders, by notice on this site, or by other acceptable means.

Collection of Information

CureDuchenne may collect personally identifiable information including but not limited to first and last names, postal addresses, email addresses, and profession, when voluntarily submitted by our visitors. The information you provide is used to fulfill your specific request and to create an account to access the Site. Except as set forth in this policy, this information is only used to fulfill your specific request, unless you give us permission to use it in another manner, for example to add you to one of our mailing lists.

Cookie/Tracking Technology

The Site may use cookie and analytic/tracking technology. Cookie and tracking technology are useful for tracking the number of visitors to the Site and understanding how visitors use the Site. Cookies can also help customize the Site for visitors. Personal information cannot be collected via cookies and other tracking technology, however, if you previously provided personally identifiable information, cookies may be tied to such information. Aggregate cookie and tracking information may be shared with third parties.

Disclosure of Information

CureDuchenne may share information collected by the Site with governmental agencies or other companies assisting us in fraud prevention or investigation. CureDuchenne may do so when: (1) permitted or required by law; or, (2) trying to protect against or prevent actual or potential fraud or unauthorized transactions; or, (3) investigating fraud which has already taken place. The information is not provided to these governmental agencies or companies for marketing purposes.

CureDuchenne may also disclose this information if CureDuchenne determines that disclosure is reasonably necessary to enforce the Site's Terms of Use or protect the Site's Users. Additionally, CureDuchenne may share personal information with its subsidiaries and affiliated entities, primarily for business and operational purposes. CureDuchenne reserves the right to disclose and transfer all information related to the Site including personal information collected to a subsequent owner, co-owner or operator of the Site or associated databases. CureDuchenne will not otherwise sell your information to third parties.

Commitment to Data Security

Your privacy is important to us. To prevent unauthorized access, maintain data accuracy, and support the correct use of information, CureDuchenne has put in place organizational, technical and administrative measures to help protect against the loss, misuse and alteration of the information under its control. CureDuchenne seeks to ensure that contractors, service providers, and other third parties who work with CureDuchenne to support its business or otherwise make the Site available (including the software, applications and services provided on our website) protect the personal information that they store, access or obtain in connection with our services, including, when possible, through contractual obligations to safeguard the confidentiality of such information and use it only for the purposes for which it is disclosed to, or accessed by, them.

While CureDuchenne endeavors to protect the privacy of your account and other personal information held in its records, CureDuchenne cannot guarantee complete security. Unauthorized entry or use, hardware or software failure, and other factors, may compromise the security of user information.

This Privacy Policy is not applicable to the websites or content of any such third parties. CureDuchenne does not exercise control over third party websites or services. These other websites or services may place their own cookies or other files on your computer, collect data or solicit personal information from you and follow different rules regarding the use or disclosure of the personal information you submit to them. If you provide any personal information through any such third party website, your transaction will occur on such third party's website (not this Site) and the personal information you provide will be collected by, and controlled by the privacy policy of, that third party. CureDuchenne recommends that you familiarize yourself with the privacy policies and practices of any such third parties, which are not governed by this Privacy Policy.

California Residents

California requires operators of websites or similar services to make certain disclosures to users who reside in California regarding their rights:

- Under California Law, a business that has an established business relationship with an individual, and has, within the immediately preceding calendar year, disclosed personal data that is primarily used for personal, family, or household purposes to a third party for the third party's direct marketing purposes, must disclose to its California users, upon request, the identity of any such third party, along with the type of personal disclosed ("Shine the Light"). Under California law, CureDuchenne is only required to respond to a user's request once during any calendar year;
- Some browsers give individuals the ability to communicate that they wish not be tracked on the internet; California law requires that CureDuchenne discloses to users how requests are treated ("Do-No-Track). The Internet industry has not yet agreed on a definition of what "Do Not Track" means, how compliance with "Do Not Track" would be measured or evaluated, or a common approach to responding to a "Do Not Track" signal. Due to the lack of guidance, CureDuchenne has not yet developed features that would recognize or respond to browser-initiated Do Not Track signals in response to California law.

Use of Site by Children

This Site may not be used by children under the age of 18 and CureDuchenne does not knowingly collect personal information from any individuals under age 18.
